AMIC is a £100m collaborative, innovative powerhouse of advanced manufacturing which is set to elevate our region globally. It is being delivered by Queen's University Belfast in partnership with industry, Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Council, Ulster University, and supported by the UK Government and Northern Ireland Executive through the Belfast Region City Deal.

Through AMIC, we are supporting economic growth and prosperity for Northern Ireland by creating high-quality jobs and increasing inward investment through high-value manufacturing innovation clusters: driving industrial transformation, paving the way for future technologies, and competing globally with a more sustainable focus.

AMIC is now progressing at pace, with construction recently starting on our state-

of-the-art Factory of the Future at Global Point in Newtownabbey, which is key to an exciting future for advanced manufacturing in Northern Ireland.

The new 10,500m² Factory of the Future will be our flagship facility and will become Northern Ireland's national centre for advanced manufacturing, significantly accelerating levels of innovation and collaboration between industry and researchers. The facility is set to open in 2026 and will give advanced manufacturing and engineering businesses access to the very latest technology, specialist equipment, and expertise.

Our team is also growing rapidly, having recently expanded to over 40 members of staff as we begin to implement our ambitious vision with enhanced capability in digitalisation, design, and sustainability, and deliver real impact across the region. AMIC's potential impact is huge. By 2050, it's estimated that our innovation centre will have contributed more than £1bn to the local economy, directly and indirectly created over 1,500 permanent jobs, and supported the training of 300 apprentices.

We're already working with our industry partners to make a difference in our communities, whether that's through our Robotics and Automation pilot programme with CAFRE in Cookstown which worked with 25 companies across Northern Ireland or working with local schools through the Advanced Manufacturing Pathways

Schools Project, helping students to learn about developing career opportunities in advanced manufacturing.

This year we've also worked with a large range of companies and partners, such as High Value Manufacturing Catapult, LMAC Consulting, and Invest NI, to elevate Northern Ireland's advanced manufacturing capability, including forging new cross-border collaborations with Louth & Meath ETB AMTCE (Advanced Manufacturing Training Centre of Excellence). Our work involves supporting industry needs and opportunities and collaborating with small and large businesses across Northern Ireland and beyond. We also collaborated to support industry in their digital journey as part of the Digital Factory Accelerator Program – supported by the Smart Industry Readiness Index (SIRI). This programme has provided industry with detailed insights, clear direction, and practical steps for each company's digital transformation and strategic planning.

The future for Northern Ireland manufacturing is bright. The Department of Business and Trade recently announced over £100 million of government-industry funding for cutting-edge aerospace tech projects to support greener air travel, including the £10.9 million Scenic Composites project – led by AMIC in partnership with Spirit AeroSystems, Denroy and Datum Tool Design. Through this project, we are developing a variety of high-value testing and manufacturing equipment which will build capability for our aerospace cluster and further consolidate its UK-leading role in advanced aerostructures.
